TO: ALL LOCALS WITH BELL ALIANT CRAFT MEMBERS

After many days of meeting with the Company over the past several months, and even with the assistance of conciliators, the tactics of the Company have made it impossible for us to bargain with them. They spoke during the last week of meetings with us about re-integration but their vision of re-integration was a mirrored collective agreement with a guaranteed number of non-unionized multi-function contractors who would continue even after full re-integration. The rest of the terms of re-integration have not even been fully discussed because we cannot get past the issue of the contractors. We believe our best option at this point is to apply to the CIRB for common-employer/sale of business for a resolution.

Bargaining is suspended at this point.

We will continue to update you as more information becomes available.
