The Union and the Company have come to an agreement on the National Policy Grievance on the HDP day for members who move to the 5/4 schedule.

For members who filed grievances on this issue you will have until October 31, 2016 to schedule the day that you lost when you moved to the 5/4. The day must be mutually agreed between yourselves and your manager.

Going forward, the following will apply:

December 1 will be the trigger date for the HDP day.

If an employee is on a 5/4 or other alternate work week, schedule on December 1, they will not be eligible for an additional HDP day to be used in the subsequent 12 month period.

- Even if an employee switches to the SDO schedule at some point during that 12 month period they will not be eligible for the additional day or any pro-rated amount.

If an employee is on the SDO schedule they will be eligible for an additional SDO, to be used in the subsequent 12 month period.

- If they are approved to switch to a 5/4 or other alternate work week, during the 12 month period, the Company will request that the employee use the HDP day before the change of schedule will take effect.
