This week we met again with the Company and devoted all of our time to job security issues. Mid-way through the week, Bell released its third quarter results revealing that gross profit exceeds 40%.

We have told the Company that it is our sweat and skill that has built, rebuilt, repaired, installed, tested and maintained the number one fibre and copper network in the country and that the Company must reward your contribution to the Company's profitability by agreeing to proposals for reasonable job protections in Article 22, training, contracting out, seniority, and work jurisdiction. Regrettably, the week produced no new agreements on these issues.

Talks resume next week in Ottawa.
